*ORDER*

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 (31 of 1946), the Central Government hereby directs that notwithstanding anything contained in the Foreigners (Exemption) Order, 1957, no foreigner shall remain *Rewalsar*, in Mandi District in the Union Territory of Himachal Pradesh, for a continuous period of more than seven days unless he has obtained permission in writing from the District Magistrate Mandi, or such other officer as may be authorised by him in this behalf;

Provided that the provisions of this Order shall not apply to, or in relation to, any foreigner-

- (i) who has been ordinarily resident in Rewalsar for a continuous period of not less than five years immediately before the date of publication of this Order; or
- (ii) who is a subject of Bhutan or Sikkim or is a national of Nepal.
